In 2013 Hunt moved from the clinical to the academic setting, working as an instructor at the University of Colorado Colorado Springs (UCCS). Hunt currently instructs primarily in the CAATE accredited Master of Science in Athletic Training program and serves as the Clinical Education Coordinator.
